

- Dual/concurrent enrollment at USC Aiken provides you with the opportunity to enhance your senior year experience through challenging college level coursework.
- Dual/concurrent enrollment eases your transition from high school to a four-year university. You'll receive instruction in traditional USC Aiken courses with University faculty and students.
- USC Aiken strongly encourages you to enroll in Advanced Placement (AP) courses that are available at your high school. Combined with dual/concurrent courses at USC Aiken, you will be well prepared for the rigors of college.
- To qualify you must:
 - be in the top 25% of your class and/or have a 3.5+ GPA on the SC UGP
 - have a score of 1020+ on SAT or PSAT (on Evidence-Based Reading/Writing and Math sections) or a 21+ on ACT/ Pre-ACT
 - be enrolled in a College Prep/Honors curriculum in high school

What will my classes be like?

All classes are university level classes. You will be expected to meet all course requirements as outlined in the course syllabus. Additionally you will follow the University's academic calendar, which is different than your high school calendar.

What courses can I take?

Each semester USC Aiken provides a listing of suggested courses for dual/concurrent students; however, you are not limited to just those courses. You may take any course for which you have met the prerequisites. The most popular courses are pre-calculus, calculus, chemistry, English 101/102, Introduction to World Civilizations, psychology, sociology and world music. Dual enrollment students are not allowed to take online courses.

What's the difference?

Dual enrollment courses allow you to receive high school and college credit for a course. If you select dual enrollment, you will receive AP weighting for the course on your high school transcript.

Concurrent enrollment courses allow you to receive only college credit for a course.

Enrolling for dual/concurrent courses at USC Aiken

Apply online at usca.edu/apply, using the "Aiken Non-Degree Seeking" application and pay the application fee online with a credit card. Print the one-page application supplement from found online at usca.edu/DE and complete with the appropriate signatures. Turn it in to your high school guidance counselor.

Please note: all admitted dual enrollment students are required to attend a special orientation session along with their parents before beginning classes.
